

Paideia Academy - Free On-Site Learning Plan:



Executive Order 2020-51 requires all schools to make a *“physical space available to students who need a place to go during the day”* as long as the physical space does not exceed health and safety guidelines outlined by the Centers for Disease Control. Schools are directed to partner with local community-based organizations such as Boys & Girls Clubs or YMCA to meet help this requirement. Paideia Academy is making the Cafenasium available until it reaches its capacity of 80 scholars. Families requesting a physical space for their scholars will be directed to the Boys & Girls Club.

Here are some frequently asked questions regarding the onsite learning option:

1) What will on-campus/Boys & Girls Club online learning look like this year?

Answer: Scholars who utilize the on-campus/Boys & Girls Club online learning option will attend their online class either from the Paideia Academies cafenasium or from the Boys & Girls Club on Southern and 7th Ave.

Scholars (kindergarten – 8th grade) will have an assigned (regularly sanitized) space to work and eat snack, breakfast, and lunch. They will attend their individual class(es) online. Paideia on-site staff or Boys & Girls Club staff will provide supervision, support, and a safe environment for scholars to attend class online. Teachers will teach from classrooms, interacting with all scholars online.

- Paideia will pay the registration and monthly tuition for scholars at the Boys & Girls Club
- Scholars are required to follow the health and safety guidelines of Paideia and Boys & Girls Club to include social distancing and wearing a face covering where required,
- Will have recess, and access to breakfast and lunch.
- Face coverings are not required at recess.
- Families are responsible for pick-up and drop-off (8:00 am class start, 3:00-3:30 pm pick-up)
- Arrangements can be made to stay later at the Boys & Girls Club.

2) Question: What is the difference between attending online at home vs. attending online on the Paideia campus or Boys & Girls Club?

Answer: Scholars attending on campus/Boys & Girls Club will be provided supervision, breakfast and lunch, recess, and support, supervision, and a safe environment to attend class online.

Scholars are allowed to bring a snack to enjoy during the school day. On-campus/Boys & Girls Club learners will wear a Paideia Academies uniform, attend online class in the cafenasium, organized by grade level.

3) How will teachers take attendance?

Answer: Teachers will take attendance using an online program called Tyler 360. Attendance will be taken beginning at 8:00 am via live Zoom check-in, in most cases.

ALL attendance rules and laws apply to the online learning platform whether the scholar is at home, at Paideia or the Boys & Girls Club.

Scholars must:

- Be ready to learn at 8:00 am
- Stay engaged in academic work throughout the day according to the schedule provided by the teacher
- Excessive absences and tardies will result in truancy citations

4) Question: What will dismissal look like during the first quarter, for scholars who are on campus/Boys & Girls Club?

Answer: For families at the Paideia facility - Families will receive a special 4-digit Pickup code for their scholar. The 4-digit Pickup code will be boldly written on the yellow card and placed on the dashboard of your car.

- All scholars will be in the Cafenadium
- THERE WILL BE NO WALK-UP option for the first quarter / Parents/guardians remain in their vehicles.
- The 4-digit Pickup code will be written on a yellow window card, placed on the dashboard of your vehicle(s).
- When the parent/guardian arrives, the code will be relayed to all staff inside supervising scholars.
- The scholar will be sent outside and ushered to their car in the parking lot pick-up area.
- Please continue to pull forward for quick dismissal.

Answer: Families at the Boys & Girls Club will follow their guidelines for dismissal.
