Hybrid Parent Choice / On-Campus or On-Line

On-Campus

- ► March 22nd Kindergarten through 3rd Grade
- March 29th 4th grade through 8th grade
- Follow all safety and mitigation requirements
 - Parent screening for fever and COVID-19 symptoms BEFORE coming to school
 - Stay home if fever of +100.4 and/or COVID-19 symptoms
 - Mask cloth face covering for everyone at all times except when eating
 - Cohort classes for physical distancing
 - Eat breakfast and lunch outside unless inclement weather
 - Dismissal from classroom parents be patient during dismissal
- Limited transportation
 - Do NOT bring a child to the bus with fever of +100.4 and/or COVID-19 symptoms
 - Parent/Guardian MUST accompany child until bus approves the child to ride
 - Must wear a cloth face covering to enter and remain on the bus

On-Line


- Scholar may remain with same teacher
 - Unless there are too many who choose to remain online
 - Teacher will focus attention on in-class scholars
 - Zoom camera will remain on with online scholars participating via Zoom and Google Classroom
 - Teacher will check in with online scholars in the course of teaching the class
- Parent agrees to:
 - supervise scholar 3-5 hours/day
 - make sure scholar logs in EVERY morning at 8:00
 - make sure scholar remain logged in the entire day
 - assist scholar with off-line assignments
 - makes sure scholar turns in assignments

 - 3 COVID-like illness: <10%


Most recent data (January 31, 2021) All data points fallin

 - Covid-like illness: 8.0% (met and falling)




CDC Data Tracker Reported Feb 22, 2021

As of February 22nd 2021.


- All Paideia Employees who are medically able are "strongly encouraged" to get vaccinated:
 - Second Dose Completed teachers 25


Paideia Hazard Mitigation Plan - COVID-19 Pandemic Response

- This bio-hazard mitigation plan was revised according to new CDC Operational Guidelines March 1, 2021 by Paideia Academies Inc. in response to bio-hazard risk presented by the pandemic conditions of Covid-19 in the South Phoenix area.
- The full mitigation plan addresses five areas of operations:
 - A) Maintaining healthy environments,
 - ▶ New Needlepoint Bi-Polar Ionization in stallation in HVAC units
 - B) Promoting behaviors that reduce spread,
 - C) Maintaining healthy operations,
 - D) Monitoring employee and student health, and
 - ► E) Plan for reopening and emergency closure of the campus facilities.
